

Chaos is a Ladder:

The last two seasons for Gastonia have been chaotic to say the least. The 2022 campaign ended in heartbreak, with Gastonia losing in five games to High Point in the division series. A year later, Gastonia made it to the final game of the season, dropping Game 5 to Lancaster in the championship series. And just like Lord Baelish remarked in "Game of Thrones," chaos isn't a pit; it's a ladder. Gastonia has built stepping stones each year, starting off with the worst record in the league in 2021 and now finishing with the most wins in the ALPB for a third consecutive season. The Club faces off against Charleston in the South Division Championship Series. So we'll find out if Gastonia's able to take the final step on the ladder in 2024.

Triumphant Triennial:

Gastonia has had the best winning percentage over a three-year stretch in Atlantic League history. From 2022-2024, Gastonia went 250-134 in the regular season, which is a winning percentage of .651. This beats out Somerset's .632 success rate from 2013-2015.

A Milestone So Nice They Reached it Twice:

Gastonia has reached the 200 home run plateau for the second consecutive season, becoming the fourth team in ALPB history to do so. The other three teams are Lexington in 2021, as well as Spire City and Gastonia in 2023. The Club has been led in the home-run department by Justin Wylie (34) and Jake Gatewood (33). Six other players have hit double-digit homers this season for the Club: Josh Stowers (17), Eric De La Rosa (14), Patrick Mazeika (14), Kevin Watson Jr. (13), Marc Flores (12) and Hidekel Gonzalez (10).
